### **SafeSchools Alert Mobile Application Download Instructions**

The SafeSchools Alert System allows our students, staff, faculty and parents to anonymously and securely submit safety tips regarding bullying, harassment, mental health, threats of violence and safety concerns to our administration team 24/7. Please go to the *App Store for iPhone* or *Google Play for Android* and download the free SafeSchools Alert Mobile App:

1. Search for the **SafeSchools Alert Mobile App** in the App Store or Google Play.
2. Select "Download" to add the free app to your mobile device.
3. The first time you open the app, you'll be asked to submit our district's four-digit code: **1352** in order to connect your tip submissions to our district team.
4. After the code is submitted, you'll be asked to confirm our district's name: **Mount Vernon School District**.
5. Once the district name is confirmed, you'll see the modules that are available to submit tips through (e.g. bullying, safety, violence).
6. You'll see a confirmation page after submission to confirm that your tip was successfully submitted.
7. Any tips that are submitted will automatically be routed to the appropriate administrators.
8. If we send any messages or replies to your tip, you will automatically receive a push notification.

El sistema SafeSchools Alert permite a los estudiantes, al personal, a la facultad y a los padres entregar de manera anónima y segura a nuestro equipo de administración, informes de seguridad en cuanto al acoso escolar, el acoso, la salud mental, las amenazas de violencia y las preocupaciones de seguridad las 24 horas los siete días de la semana.

Sírvase visitar la *App Store* para *iPhone* o *Google Play* para *Android* y descargue la aplicación móvil SafeSchools Alert gratis:

1. Haga una búsqueda de la aplicación móvil **SafeSchools Alert** en la App Store o en Google Play.
2. Seleccione “Descargar” (Download) para agregar la aplicación gratis a su dispositivo móvil.
3. La primera vez que abra la aplicación, se le pedirá que ingrese el código de nuestro distrito de cuatro números: **1352**, esto permitirá conectar el envío de sus informes con nuestro equipo del distrito.
4. Una vez enviado el código, se le pedirá confirmar el nombre de nuestro distrito: **Mount Vernon School District**.
5. Una vez confirmado el nombre del distrito, podrá ver los módulos que están disponibles mediante los cuales podrá entregar informes (p. ej., acoso escolar, seguridad, violencia).
6. Una vez enviada la recomendación, verá una página de confirmación confirmando que su informe ha sido enviado con éxito.
7. Cualquier informe enviado será automáticamente dirigido a los administradores apropiados.
8. Si enviamos algún mensaje o respondemos a su informe, automáticamente recibirá una notificación de inserción.

## Palabra de la Semana



*La sal era una medida de valor en la Antigüedad*

### salario

La sal desempeñó un papel muy importante en la economía de las sociedades de la Antigüedad clásica, no solo por su valor de uso (condimento, fabricación de tintes y jabones y, sobre todo, como conservante de carnes y pescados), sino también como medida de valor y como medio de cambio, al punto de que en algunas sociedades se usó como referencia para la paga de los soldados (en aquellos tiempos, cuando no existía la gran industria actual, era la única remuneración que se pagaba de manera uniforme a un gran número de personas).

En la Roma de los césares, del latín *sal* 'sal' se derivó el adjetivo *salarium*, que significaba 'de la sal, perteneciente a la sal', y de este se formó el sustantivo *salarium* 'ración de sal', 'salario', con el que se designaba el sueldo de los soldados.

La raíz del vocablo latino *sal* está en el indoeuropeo *sal-*, con idéntico significado, de donde también proceden palabras como *salsa*, *salame*, *salino*, *salitre*.
